5. ENTRIES

Refusal of entries shall be in accordance with NCR 83 & the relevant Category Sporting Regulations. The maximum number of entries will be 250. Such fees shall not be refundable except -

- (a) In the case of abandonment, cancellation or postponement of the meeting, in accordance with NCR59.
- (b) **In the case of competitor's cars withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Meeting no later than nine days before the meeting.**
- (c) International competitors must comply with Appendix K of the International Sporting Code of the FIA. Entries from international competitors will be accepted, subject to being granted a visa from CAMS. A fee of \$25 will be charged to cover administrative costs associated with a refund. Any cheque dishonoured will incur the bank fee as well as a \$25 administration fee. Entries accepted in order of receipt.

6. EVENTS

For vehicles complying with the regulations as outlined in the current CAMS manual of motor sport, and for the categories as detailed in the 2010 SA State Motor Racing Championship Series Regulations.

7. RACES

8. AWARDS

9. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors must hold the minimum of a current CAMS level PCC licence.

10. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The organisers utilise an automatic timing system, which requires all vehicles to be fitted with an operable Dorian DATA-1 timing transmitter, which is the competitor's responsibility. Data 1 transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, 6/29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing, VIC, 3129. **The transmitter number must be recorded on the entry form.**

13. ANTI DOPING POLICY

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

14. PROTESTS

16. MEDICAL
